

GERMAN SHEPHERD DOG CLUB OF AMERICA

HIGHEST PLACING AMERICAN BRED

To qualify for the Highest Placing American-Bred in selected classes offered at the German Shepherd Dog Club of America Sieger Show, the following criteria must be met.

- Breeder of the dog must be a member in good standing of the German Shepherd Dog Club of America (GSDCA) and reside in the United States.
- 2. Owner of the dog must be a member in good standing of the German Shepherd Dog Club of America (GSDCA) and reside in the United States.
- 3. The dog must be AKC registered
- 4. The dog must carry an American breeder's kennel name.
- 5. The dog must be part of an AKC registered litter.
- 6. The Highest Placing American Bred award goes to the owner, with recognition being given to the breeder of the dog.
- 7. Dogs shown in the 12-18 Month, 18-24 Month and Working Dog Classes, both Stock and LSH, are eligible for this award
